WATER SUPPLY DISRUPTION...Sections of Clarendon & the Corporate Area

The National Water Commission is advising customers in **sections of Clarendon** who are served by the **Sevens Well** that the disruption they are currently experiencing in their water supply is due to leak repair works being carried out on a 6" distribution main.

Areas affected by this disruption in service include:

Sevens Estate Ltd, Sevens Road, Sevens Plantation, Effortville, Oliver Gardens, Warsop Farm, Zion Avenue, Leon Avenue, Donald Avenue, Atkinson Drive, Alexander Avenue, Mt. Clair, Bryants Crescent, Stewart Avenue, Sewell Crescent, Windsor Avenue, Fosmore Drive and sections of May Pen Town.

In the meanwhile, some **corporate area** customers are experiencing a similar disruption in their service, also due to leak repair activities being carried out on a distribution pipeline along Haining Road.

Areas affected include:

New Kingston, Stanton Terrace, sections of Lady Musgrave Road, Braemar Avenue, Braemar Road and Trafalgar Road.

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience caused and is making every effort to restore water supply to all the affected areas within the shortest possible time.
