URGENT MAINTENANCE WORK TO DISRUPT WATER SUPPLY TO SECTIONS OF ST. JAMES

National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that the Pitfour Deep Well and the Appleton Spring Pumping Station in St. James will be shut down to facilitate urgent maintenance work.

The Pitfour Deep Well will be out of operation from 07:00 a.m. on Tuesday, December 20, 2011 until 02:00 p.m. on Thursday, December 22, 2011. Customers in Pitfour, sections of Granville and sections of Retirement, who are served by this system, will therefore experience a disruption in their water supply.

At the same time, customers in Appleton Spring, Sign, Orange, Moore Park, Sudbury, Rocky Road and Latium, who are served by the Appleton Spring Pumping Station, will experience a disruption in their water supply from 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, December 21, 2011 until 02:00 p.m. on Friday, December 23, 2011.

The NWC craves the patience and understanding of its valued customers and will, as an interim measure, truck water to the affected areas.

The NWC apologises for any inconvenience this break in service may cause.
