SCHEDULED DISRUPTIONS FOR SECTIONS OF ST. ANDREW

As the National Water Commission continues the **Jamaica Water Supply Improvement Project (JWSIP) works in sections of St. Andrew**, customers in Stony Hill and its environs will experience low water pressure or be without their regular piped water supply.

The disruptions will be in effect from **Monday, December 19, 2011 to Friday, December 23, 2011 between 8:00 am and 8:00 pm.** and will facilitate upgrading works to be carried out at the Seaview Treatment facility.

Similarly, customers served by the **Constant Spring Treatment Plant** will experience disruption in their supply on Tuesday, December 20, 2011 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. The disruption is to facilitate works to be carried out on the facility.

Areas that will be affected include: **Constant Spring Road, Norbrook, Cherry Gardens, Havendale, Lady Musgrave Avenue, Sections of Half-Way-Tree Road, Manor Park, Riva Ridge, Mannings Hill Road, Red Hills Road, Smokey Vale, Chancery Hall Heights, Jacks Hill, Tavistock and Essex Hall.**

The National Water Commission regrets any inconvenience caused by this necessary improvement work and urges customers in the mentioned areas to store water for use during the period of disruption.
