The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that as a result of mechanical problems at the Greater Mandeville Water Supply facility, some customers in Manchester are experiencing a disruption in their water supply.

The areas that are impacted include: **Farm, sections of New Forest, sections of New Green, Nain, Spur Tree, Greenvale, Hatfield, Dunrobin, Balvenie, Mandeville Town, Georges Valley, Richmond, Old England, Gray Ground, New Port, Wards Avenue, Hartease, Albion, May Day, Brumalia, Marshalls Pen, Mike Town, Lincoln and Huntley.**

Every effort is being made to restore the water supply on Friday, December 23, 2011.
