**JPSCo MAINTENANCE WORKS TO DISRUPT WATER SUPPLY

The NWC is advising customers served by the **Constant Spring Treatment Plant in St. Andrew** that the facility will be shutdown on **Tuesday, January 10, 2012 from 10:00pm to 4:00am on Wednesday, January 11, 2012** as well as on **Wednesday, January 11, 2012 from 10:00pm to 4:00am on Thursday, January 12, 2012**. Customer will experience low water pressure and or no water during these disruptions.

This is to facilitate urgent maintenance works to be carried out by the **Jamaica Public Service Company (JPSCo)** at the **Constant Spring Treatment Plant**.

Areas to be affected will include:

Constant Spring, Norbrook, Cherry Gardens, Havendale, Half Way Tree, Lady Musgrave, Liguanea, Manor Park, Shortwood, Graham Heights, Aylsham, Allerdyce, Acadia, White Hall Gardens, Belgrade, Kingswood, Riva Ridge, Eastwood Park. Gardens, Hughenden and Stillwell Road.
