SCHEDULED DISRUPTION FOR STONY HILL ... JWSIP WORKS

As works progress under the **Jamaica Water Supply Improvement Project (JWSIP)**, the National Water Commission is advising customers in the **Stony Hill areas of St. Andrew** that the **Seaview Filter Plant will be shut down for the period Tuesday, January 10 through to Wednesday, January 11, 2012.** This necessary shutdown is to facilitate extensive works to the plant and supply network as works advance steadily under the project.

Customers in the following areas will have no water for the period that the plant will be out of operation:

- **Stony Hill and surrounding areas**
- **Old Stony Hill Road**
- **Golden Spring and surrounding areas**
- **Jacks Hill**
- **Stilwell Road**
- **Lawrence Tavern**
- **Tavistock**
- **Sections of Mannings Hill**
- **Bridgemount**
- **Sunset Avenue**
- **Boone Hall and Mt. Ogle**
- **Temple Hall**
- **Bowden Hill**

The NWC is reporting that operations will resume at the facility on **Wednesday evening** and that customers should have full restoration of service on **Thursday, January 12, 2012.** The company is also reminding customers in the areas served by the system that operations will resume on the usual regulated basis and as such the areas will see the return of their water supply on their scheduled service days.

Whereas trucked water will be provided to the affected areas in order to minimize the extent of this scheduled disruption, customers are also being urged to store water for use as far as is possible.

The National Water Commission regrets any inconvenience caused by these necessary improvement works and will provide further updates in this regard.
