WATER SUPPLY DISRUPTION AFFECTS SECTIONS OF ST. JAMES AND ST. ANN

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that the Pitfour Deep Well in St. James will be shut down today, between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and 05:00 p.m. to facilitate urgent leak repair work in Pitfour and Granville.

As a result, customers in Pitfour, sections of Granville and sections of Retirement, will experience a disruption in their water supply over the stipulated period.

At the same time, customers in New Ground, Lime Hall, Clamstead, Laycock and Gravel Hill are experiencing a disruption in their water supply due to mechanical problems at the New Ground Pumping Station in St. Ann.

Every effort is being made to effect the necessary repairs and restore water on Friday, January 20, 2011. In the interim, the NWC will continue to truck water to the affected areas in St. Ann.

The NWC craves the patience and understanding of its valued customers and apologises for any inconvenience caused.
