WATER DISRUPTION AFFECTS SECTIONS OF CLARENDON AND MANCHESTER

The National Water Commission is advising customers in Spaulding, Limit, George North, Glenco, Glenco Housing Scheme, Richmond, Santa Hill, Bamboo, Cobbla and Baileston that the water disruption they are experiencing is as a result of pipeline interconnection work in Spaulding.

It was expected that the work would have been completed today, as stated in previous advisory; however, this deadline had to be revised due to challenges associated with the laying of the pipes.

The NWC apologizes for any inconvenience caused by this disruption in supply and assures customers that every effort is being made to complete the interconnection work by 10:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 17, 2012.

The NWC craves the patience of its valued customers and will, as an interim measure, continue to truck water to the affected areas.
