**JWSIP WORKS TO CAUSE NO WATER IN STONY HILL AREAS, ST. ANDREW**

The National Water Commission is advising that the Ginger River intake which supplies raw water to the **Seaview Filter Plant in St. Andrew** will be shutdown for the period **Tuesday, January 23, to Thursday, January 26, 2011**. This necessary shutdown is being carried out as part of the **Jamaica Water Supply Improvement Project (JWSIP)** works, and will result in the closure of the Seaview Filter Plant for the period.

Customers in the following areas will therefore have no water for the duration of the works.

**Stony Hill  
Temple Hall  
Golden Spring  
Jack's Hill  
Stillwell Road  
Lawrence Tavern  
Tavistock  
Mannings Hill  
Bridge Mount  
Sunset Avenue  
Boone Hall and Mt. Ogle.**

Customers in these areas are therefore being urged to store water for the period of disruption. Trucked water will also be provided where necessary to minimize the extent of this interruption in service.

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience that may be caused and will make every effort to restore water supply by 6:00pm on Thursday evening.
