WATER SUPPLY DISRUPTION..CONSTANT SPRING, ST. ANDREW

The National Water Commission is advising customers served by the **Constant Spring Treatment Plant in St. Andrew** that they will have no water on **Thursday, January 26, 2012 between the hours of 9:00am and 3:00pm**. This necessary interruption in service is as a result of works to be carried out under the Jamaica Water Supply Improvement Project (JWSIP).

Areas that will be impacted include:

Constant Spring Road, Norbrook, Cherry Gardens, Havendale, Lady Musgrave, Sections of Half-Way-Tree Road, Manor Park, Kingswood, Riva Ridge, Eastwood Park Gardens, Camperdown, Mannings Hill Road, Red Hills Road, Arlene Gardens, Roehampton, Smokey Vale, Lower Jacks Hill Road, Chancery Hall Heights, Jacks Hill, Tavistock, Trench Town, Essex Hall and Calabar Mews, Long Lane and Stillwell Road.

Customers in the Norbrook area are also being advised that they will experience an extended disruption in their supply and will therefore not see the return of their service until Friday, January 27. This is due to works that will be carried out on the pump that serves the community.

Customers who will be impacted by these works are therefore being urged to store water for use until the restoration of normal water supply.

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience that may be caused and will endeavour to have normal service restored within the specified time.
