Moravia and Two Meetings Out of Operation

National Water Commission (NWC) customers in Manchester and Clarendon, who are served by the Two Meetings and Moravia Treatment Plants in Manchester, will experience an interruption in their water supply. This is as a result of the high levels of turbidity impacting normal operations at both facilities.

The impacted service areas include:

- Bailleston, Sedgeburgh, Limit, Spaulding, Knox and surrounding areas, served by the Two Meetings system
- Coleyville, Line of Parish, Sucee, Sawmill, Silent Hill, Ticky Ticky, Pike, Christiana, Joblane, Savoy, Wild-man Street, Brockery, Sedgeburgh, Limit, Richmon, Cobbla, Chuleigh, Holmwood, Malton, Hundersfield and Mollison, served by the Moravia system.

The NWC will resume normal operations at both facilities as soon as the high levels of turbidity subside.
