**HIGH TURBIDITY LEVELS AND SINGLE PHASE POWER PROBLEMS
IMPACTING NWC FACILITIES IN SEVERAL PARISHES, DUE TO RAINS**

Operations at several **National Water Commission** facilities across the Parishes of **Clarendon, St. Catherine, St. Thomas and Rural St. Andrew**, have been impacted by high levels of turbidity and single phase power supply problems, due to the current weather condition.

Facilities affected include:

Clarendon: - Sevens, Kellits and Woodside Pumping Stations

St. Catherine: - Lluidas Vale, Wakefield, Tulloch Spring, Goldmine and Sue River Pumping Stations

St. Thomas: - Apple Farm and Albion Heights Pumping Stations

Rural St. Andrew: - Rock Hall, McGowan Spring, Mahoney, Drummond, Halls Delight, King Weston, Isaac Hole, Halls Green, Castle James and Bucky Plain Pumping Stations

Customers will have their water supply restored as soon as turbid conditions have improved and power restored to the respected facilities.
