NWC CONDEMNS ACTS OF TAMPERING

The NWC is condemning a recent act by unscrupulous persons who trespassed on the NWC's facility in Seville, St Ann.

It is reported that said persons (s) attempted to install an illegal connection to the NWC's water main and this caused a disruption in water supply to the **Seville, Priory communities** as well as the **St Ann Bay's Hospital**.

The swift response of the Police was vital in averting any significant damage to the facility against this selfish act. Currently, the company's security team has commenced its investigation and will be working with the local security forces to pursue this matter to the full extent of the law.

In recent months, the National Water Commission has increased its activities against persons found carrying out these unlawful activities and so the public is also being reminded that it is illegal for any person to attempt to make a connection to the NWC network, or to tamper with its equipment.

Persons caught committing such acts face being taken to court, possible jail time as well as significant fines.
