NWC CONTINUES NON-REVENUE WATER REDUCTION PROGRAMME IN THE CORPORATE AREA

DUHANEY PARK, PERKINS BOULEVARD AND SURROUNDING AREAS TO BE AFFECTED

The National Water Commission is advising that as part of its ongoing **Non-Revenue Water Reduction** programme being carried out with Co-management Partners **Miya International**, the company will be conducting maintenance works along its pipe network within the **Corporate Area**.

These works are scheduled to be carried out on **Thursday, September 14, 2017 to Friday, September 15, 2017 from 10pm to 4am**.

Customers will therefore experience low water pressure or no water conditions and are being encouraged to store water for use during the period of disruption.

Areas to be affected will include **Duhaney Park, Patrick City, New Haven, Perkins Boulevard and Meadowbrook Estate**.
