Area to be affected: **Hermitage Dam Road**



**Thursday, October 12, 2017 from 2:00 pm to 3:00 pm**

Areas to be affected: **Panton Drive, Panton Circle, Ridgeview Drive, Christopher Drive.**



Customers will experience water supply disruptions and are being encouraged to store water for use during the time specified. Additionally, motorists are being advised to observe the traffic signals of the work crews on site.
