The National Water Commission wishes to advise the public that high turbidity has forced the shutdown of the Kellits water supply facility in the parish of Clarendon. This issue will result in water supply disruptions for customers in the areas served by the facility.

Affected Areas include: **Kellits, Crofts Hill, Good Hope, Tait, Pedro, Rhoden Hall, Guava Ground, Hickery, Comsie and Jericho**

The Company is advising that normal operations will be restored as soon as the issue is resolved.

The NWC apologises to its valued customers for any inconvenience caused and seeks to assure them that every effort will be made to restore regular water supply in the shortest possible time.
