The National Water Commission is advising that water distribution on the Spanish Town Road network in St Andrew will be suspended on starting tonight, December 4, 2021 in order to facilitate pipeline repairs along the network.

During these activities, customers are being urged that where possible to store water for use as the period of disruption will be throughout Sunday, December 5, 2021.

Areas to be affected: **Marcus Garvey Drive, Spanish Town Road and all roads leading off, sections of Washington Gardens, Cooreville Gardens and New Haven**
