**SCHEDULED JPSCo MAINTENANCE WORKS TO DISRUPT WATER SUPPLY
SOME SECTIONS OF ST. CATHERINE AND ST. ANDREW WILL BE AFFECTED**

The National Water Commission is advising that scheduled **JPSCo maintenance works** will disrupt operations at the **Tulloch Spring and Bybrook #2 and 4 Water Facilities** on **Sunday, December 5, 2021** between **8:30 am** and **6:00 p.m.** Customers served by the facilities may experience low pressure or no water conditions.

The NWC is therefore urging its valued customers to store water for use during the period and seeks to assure them that regular water supply will be restored following the return of electricity to the areas.

Areas to be affected: **Kent Village, Spanish Town Road, Molyne's Road, Washington Boulevard, Sections of Downtown Kingston, Hamilton Gardens, Christian Gardens & Pen, Newland Road, Cumberland, Cedar Grove, Edgewater, Waterford, Gregory Park, Braeton, Independence City, Hellshire, Eltham Acres, Eltham, Greendale, Keystone, St Jago Gardens, Patten Park, Richard Hall, Waterloo Gardens and Ensom Acres**
