HIGH TURBIDITY LEVELS AND HEAVY SILTATION IMPACTING SOME WATER FACILITIES IN ST. ANDREW AND ST. THOMAS

The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to advise its Customers that due to the heavy rainfall being experienced across the island, some facilities in **St. Andrew and St. Thomas** are out of operation, as a result of either high turbidity levels or heavy siltation affecting inflows.

Customers are being advised that once the conditions are favorable, the necessary remedial activities will be carried out to facilitate the re-start of operations and water supply distribution.
