**UPDATE**

**DAMAGED MOTOR DISRUPTS WATER SUPPLY TO ENSOM CITY AREAS  
TRUCKING ARRANGEMENTS NOW MOBILISED FOR IMPACTED AREAS**

The National Water Commission (NWC) is updating that the shutdown at the Ensom City facility in St. Catherine is due to a burnt motor that will require the extraction and remedial work for repairs.

Based on an initial assessment carried out earlier today, Tuesday, September 28, 2022, to determine a restoration timeline- the NWC's maintenance crew has projected that the work will take 3-4 days for completion.

Estimated Restoration Time: **6pm on Saturday, September 27, 2022**

Based on this situation, the NWC team has mobilised trucking arrangements for the affected customers who may be experiencing an extended period of no water conditions to their communities.

Affected areas include: **Ensom City H/S, Ensom Acres Housing Scheme, Gordon Pen**

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this disruption may cause and craves the patience and understanding of its valued customers.
