## **URGENT JPSCO WORK TO IMPACT WATER SUPPLY OPERATIONS IN ST CATHERINE**

**SECTIONS OF PORTMORE, HELLSHIRE AND ST ANDREW TO BE AFFECTED**

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that its **Wells E, H and W** at the **Eastern Headworks** facility in St Catherine will be shut down on Thursday, September 29, 2022 in order to facilitate urgent JPSCO works ( 4 hours) and the subsequent time for recharge of the pipeline network.

The company is noting that the disruptions will impact a number of Portmore and St Andrew communities that are served by the plants. Customers in these areas are therefore being urged to store water for use during this period.

Work period: **9am to 5pm on Thursday, September 29, 2022**

Areas Affected: **Kent Village, Spanish Town Road, Molynes Road, Washington Boulevard, Sections of Downtown Kingston, Hamilton Gardens, Christian Gardens & Pen, Newland Road, Cumberland, Cedar Grove, Bridgeport, Bridgeview, Westport, Edgewater, Waterford, Gregory Park, Braeton, , Independence City, Eltham Acres, Eltham, Greendale, Keystone, St Jago Gardens, Patten Park, Richard Hall, Waterloo Gardens and Ensom Acres**

Other areas include: **Upperfort A & B, Johnson Hill, Edge Hill, Hellshire Hills, Cave Hill Estate, Hillshire Glades, Seaforth, Sand Hill Vista, Hellshire Heights Main Road, Hellshire Heights Ph # 3 and 4, Hellshire Park H/S**

The National Water Commission seeks to assure the public that regular water supply operations will be restarted as soon as the power supply problems are corrected.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this disruption may cause and craves the patience and understanding of its valued customers.
