The National Water Commission is advising that its teams are now mobilising to commence emergency pipeline repairs to a section of pipeline on the **Washington Boulevard in St Andrew**. This issue will cause a water supply disruption to communities of **Duhaney Park and surrounding** areas.

Estimated restoration time: **5pm, Today, Friday- September 30, 2022**

Affected Areas include: **Duhaney Park, New Haven, Patrick City, Washington Gardens, Sections of Molyne's Road, Penwood, Waterhouse, Seaward Drive and sections of Olympic Gardens**

Motorists are also being urged to exercise caution as patience as there will be a possible impact on traffic flow.

The National Water Commission apologises for any inconvenience caused and seeks to assure its valued customers that every effort will be made to restore water supply within the shortest possible time.
