ELECTRICAL CHALLENGES AFFECTING GREATER MANDEVILLE WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM

The National Water Commission extends its apologies to customers in Manchester and St. Elizabeth who are served by the Greater Mandeville Water Supply System for the current interruption in water supply. This disruption is due to a Jamaica Public Service Company (JPS) low voltage problem at the Pepper #3 plant and an internal electrical issue at the Spur Tree Facility.

The NWC has reported the low voltage issue at the Pepper plant to the JPS for correction. Meanwhile, the NWC maintenance team is working assiduously to resolve the internal issue at the Spur Tree facility resolved.

The areas affected include *Sections of Pepper, Lucky Valley, Ruinett, sections of New Forest, Farm, sections of Nain, Spur Tree, Greenvale, Hatfield, Dunrobin, Balvenie, Mandeville Town, Georges Valley, Richmond, Old England, Gray Ground, Heartease, Woodlawn Housing Scheme, Caledonia Road, Caledonia Meadows, May Day, Brumalia Road, Marshalls Pen, Mike Town, Balcarres, McKinley Road, Gordon Road* and surrounding areas.

The NWC regrets the inconvenience caused and appreciates the patience and understanding of its valued customers. The Company assures that every effort is being made to restore regular water supply as swiftly as possible.
