**JPS POWER OUTAGE IMPACTING WATER SUPPLY IN SECTIONS OF ST. ELIZABETH**

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that a power supply outage is currently impacting water supply to customers in sections of St. Elizabeth who are served by the **Dalintober, Union, South Hampton, Long Hill, Burnt Savannah, Bogue, Maggoty** and **Content** facilities. This disruption is as a result of a damaged Jamaica Public Service (JPS) transformer in the Maggoty area.

Customers are being assured that normal operations will resume at the facilities as soon as the issue is resolved by the power service provider. In the interim, customers may contact the NWC Toll-Free line at 888-225-5692 or by following the NWC social media @nwcjam for updates.
