The National Water Commission (NWC) is working to restore water supply to customers along the Martha Brae to Montego Bay corridor. This after major leaks occurred on the pipeline network in the vicinity of the Hyatt Zilara resort earlier today.

Estimated repair completion time is by 12 midnight today Wednesday, February 12, 2025. After which, gradual recharge of the pipeline will take place.
