## HIGH TURBIDITY DISRUPTS WATER SUPPLY TO SECTIONS OF MANCHESTER AND TRELAWNY

The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to apologise to customers served by the **Moravia Treatment** plant in **Manchester** and the **Ulster Spring Pumping Station** in **Trelawny**, for the disruption in their water supply due to high turbidity at the facilities.

Customers are being assured that water supply will return as soon as the turbidity subsides.

Areas affected in **Manchester** include **Christiana, Spalding, Coleyville, Chudleigh, Malton, Molliston, Devon, Farm, Richmond, Sedburgh, Whiteshop, Walderson, Cobbla, Silent Hill, Dump, Huddersfield, Succeed, Bryce, Dump, Dobson, Line of Parish, Silent Hill, Tick Ticky** and surrounding areas.

Areas affected in **Trelawny** include **Ulster Spring, Albert Town, Bamboo, Freeman's Hall, Lot and German Town.**
