HIGH TURBIDITY AFFECTS SECTIONS OF ST JAMES AND ST ELIZABETH

The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to apologise to customers served by the **Tangle River, Vaughnsfield and Niagara** systems in **St James**, as well as the **Benlmonds** system in **St Elizabeth**, for the disruption in their water supply due to levels of high turbidity which is affecting the facilities.

Customers are being assured that their water supply will return as soon as the turbidity subsides.

Areas affected in St James include **Tangle River, German Town, sections of Garlands, Niagara, Johnson and Jointwood.**

Areas affected in St Elizabeth include **Elderslie, Accompong, Benlmonds, Siloah, Thornton, Williamsfield, Windsor Spring, Pang Town and Bagdale Mountain.**

The NWC regrets any inconvenience caused and craves the patience and understanding of its valued customers.
