Clarks Town Pumping Station- Trelawny	Clarks Town, Duncans, Duncans Hill, Hyde, Kinloss, Crawle, Gibraltar, Georgia, Logwood Walk and surrounding areas.
Sherwood Pumping Station- Trelawny	Sherwood, Peidmount, Reserve and Coxheath

The NWC is assuring customers that water supply will return as soon as the turbidity levels subside.
