**OPERATIONAL CHALLENGES IMPACTING GREAT RIVER  
AND MARTHA BRAE TREATMENT PLANTS**

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that, the **Great River Treatment Plant** in **St James** and the **Martha Brae Treatment plant** in **Trelawny**, are currently impacted by operational challenges. As a result, customers in **St James, Trelawny, Hanover** and **St Ann**, who area served by these facilities will experience a disruption in their water supply.

Every effort is being to restore full operation at both facilities in the shortest possible time.

Areas affected in **St. James** include **Guava Walk, Unity Hall, Spring Gardens, Tower Hill, Belmont, Wiltshire, Moy Hall, Reading Heights, Catherine Hall, West Green, Freeport, Mango Walk, Fairview, sections of Gloucester Avenue, Norwood, Downtown Montego Bay, Glendevon, Mango Walk, Greenwood, Rose Hall, Coral Gardens, Ironshore, Rhyne Park, Spot Valley, Cornwall, Mt. Zion, Palmyra, Saigon, Barrett Town and Providence Heights.**

Areas affected in **Hanover** include **Kew, Elgin Town, Johnson Town, Brisette, Hoist, Malcolm Heights, Cacoon, Dias, First Hill, Montpelier, Bamboo, McQuarrie, Camp Road, Zion, Bushland, Hopewell, Woodland, Tamarind Hill, Sandy Bay, Esher, Pedro, Haughton Court, Providence and Blenheim.**

Areas affected in **Trelawny** include **Falmouth, Falmouth Pier, Royalton Hotel, Rock, Cooper's Pen, Granville, Green Park, Schawfield, Silver Sands, Duncan's Bay, Carey Park, Stewart Castle, Salt Marsh, Davis Pen, Stonebrook Vista, Florence Hall Village, Coral Spring Village, Wiltshire, Hague, Hague Housing scheme, Daniel Town, Hammersmith and Retreat Heights.**
