## **EMERGENCY PIPELINE REPAIR WORK TO AFFECT WATER SUPPLY TO SECTIONS OF MANCHESTER**

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising customers served by the **Moravia Treatment Plant** in **Manchester**, that they will experience a disruption in their water supply from **10:00 pm Friday, July 1, 2022** through to **5:00 pm Saturday, July 2, 2022**. This is to facilitate emergency repair works on a 10” pumping main.

Customers are being assured that every effort will be made to complete the necessary repair and restore supply within the specified time.

Areas to be affected include **Christiana, Spalding, Coleyville, Chudleigh, Malton, Molliston, Devon, Farm, Richmond, Sedburgh, Whiteshop, Walderson, Cobbla, Silent Hill, Dump, Huddersfield, Succeed, Bryce, Dump, Dobson, Line of Parish, Silent Hill, Tick Ticky** and surrounding areas.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this disruption may cause and urges customers to store water for use during the period of downtime.
