MAINTENANCE WORK TO BE CARRIED OUT AT GUTTERS FACILITY, MANCHESTER

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that, it will be carrying out maintenance work at the **Gutters/ Spur Tree** facility in **Manchester**, from **Monday July 18 through to Friday July 29, 2022**. During this period, the facility will operate at 50 per cent capacity.

Due to this necessary work, customer served by the Greater Mandeville Water Supply System will experience either low water pressure or intermittent supply.

Areas likely to be affected include *Pepper, Downs, Spur Tree, Prospect, sections of New Forest, Nain, Sea Air, Greenvale, Hatfield, Dunrobin, Balevine, Mandeville Town, Georges Valley, Hillside, Richmond, Old England, Grey Ground, New Port, Wards Avenue, Heartease, Knockpartick, Woodlawn Housing scheme, Caledonia Road, Caledonia Meadows, Albion, May Day, Brumalia, Marshalls Pen, Waltham, Perth, Cedar Gardens, Mike Town, Lincoln, Huntley* and surrounding areas.

Customers are being assured that the NWC will be working assiduously to complete the work and restore normal operations at the facility within the time specified.
