The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that, it will be carrying out urgent maintenance work at the **Great River Treatment Plant** in **St. James**, on **Monday, May 13, 2024, between the hours of 7:00 am and 9:00 pm**. As a result, customers in sections of **St James** and **Hanover**, who are served by this facility will experience either low or no water during the period.

Customers are being assured that every effort will be made to complete the necessary work and resume regular operation at the facility within the time specified.

Areas likely to be affected in **St. James** include **Guava Walk, Unity Hall, Spring Gardens, Tower Hill, Belmont, Wiltshire, Moy Hall, Reading Heights, Catherine Hall, West Green, Freeport, Mango Walk, Fairview**, sections of **Gloucester Avenue, Norwood, Downtown Montego Bay, Glendevon and Mango Walk**.

Areas likely to be affected in **Hanover** include **Kew, Elgin Town, Johnson Town, Brisette, Hoist, Malcolm Heights, Cacoon, Dias, First Hill, Montpelier, Bamboo, McQuarrie, Camp Road, Zion, Bushland, Hopewell, Woodland, Tamarind Hill, Sandy Bay, Esher, Pedro, Haughton Court, Providence and Blenheim**.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this may cause and urges customers to store water for use during the outline period.
