**MECHANICAL CHALLENGES DISRUPT WATER
SUPPLY TO SECTIONS OF MANCHESTER**

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that, due to mechanical challenges at the Pepper # 3 facility, customers served by the Greater Mandeville system in Manchester, will experience low water pressure.

Every effort is being made to resolve the challenges and resume normal operation at the facility by Thursday, October 18, 2017.

Areas likely to be affected include: *Downs, Prospect, section of New Forest, Farm, sections of Nain, Sea Air, Spur Tree, Greenvale, Hatfield, Dunrobin, Balvenie, section of Mandeville, Georges Valley, Hillside, Richmond, Old England, Grey Ground, Ward Avenue, Heartease, Woodlawn Housing Scheme, Caledonia Road, Caledonia Meadows, May Day, Brumalia Road, Marshalls Pen, Mike Town, Balcarres, McKinley Road, Gordon Road and surrounding areas.*
