Spanish Town, Westmore, Hampton Green, Lakemore Gardens, Newton Avenue, Nugent Street, McCoy's Land, Mayfair Mews, Brunswick Avenue, Job's Lane, White Water Meadows, Hartlands, McCooks Pen, Leiba Gardens, Sydenham Gardens, Wedge Wood Gardens, Willowdene Housing Scheme and Hopedale Housing Scheme.

Lluidas Vale Filter Plant

Lluidas Vale, Worthy Park and Tydixon.

Customers are being assured that the National Water Commission will restore their regular water supply as soon as normality returns to these Facilities.
