WATER SUPPLY DISRUPTIONS

The National Water Commission is advising customers in some sections of St Mary, who are served by the Trinity Pumping Station, that the disruption they are currently experiencing in their water supply is as a result of electrical problems at the Station.

Areas impacted are :

Cambridge Heights, Albion Mountain, Trinity Land, Gray Street, Sandside and Rangolan Scheme

Following the completion of assessment, the NWC will provide a further update regarding the resumption of operations at the facility. In the interim water will be trucked to the affected areas.

Meanwhile in Rural St. Andrew, customers served by both King Weston and Drummond Water Facilities are without water due to turbidity and blockages affecting operations.

Areas affected are

Sections of Bucky Plain, Belmont, Grant Hill, Florence Hill, Lawrence Tavern, Mount Ogle, Mathew Road, Toms River, Cokely, Johnny Ridge Bull Bay, Windsor Lodge, Greenvale Road, Nine & Ten Miles, Taylo Lands, Tamrind Tree Old Road, Tana Hill and Clement Road

The National Water Commission apologises for any inconvenience caused by these disruptions in service.
