**BROKEN MAIN DISRUPTS WATER SUPPLY IN KINGSTON AND ST ANDREW

The National Water Commission is advising that some customers in sections of Kingston and St Andrew are now experiencing a disruption in their regular water supply which is as a result of a broken water main along the NWC's network in the Ferry area.

The Company's operations team is now commencing the necessary emergency repair work that is estimated to be completed by this evening, **Thursday, January 11, 2018.**

Areas Affected: **Downtown Kingston, Spanish Town Road, Duhaney Park, Washington Gardens & Washington Boulevard, Valentine Gardens, Patrick City and sections of Havendale.**

The NWC apologizes to its valued customers for any inconvenience caused and seeks to assure them that every effort will be made to restore regular water supply in the shortest possible time.
