NWC customers in sections of **St. Catherine, Corporate Area and St. Mary** are currently experiencing water supply disruptions as a result of power outages and pipeline repairs at some facilities.

Affected areas and facilities are:

St. Catherine:-

Wells H and G Pump Stations -

Kent Village, Spanish Town Road, Molynes Road, Washington Boulevard, sections of Downtown Kingston, Hamilton Gardens, Christian Gardens, Christian Pen, Newland Road, Cumberland, Cedar Grove, Edgewater, Waterford, Gregory Park, Braeton, Independence City and Hellshire.

Twickenham Park Pump Station –

Twickenham Park Industrial Estate, sections of Spanish Town, Greendale, section of Lauriston, Union Estate, Central Village and Twickenham Housing Scheme.

Little Greendale Pump Station –

Little Greendale, sections of Lauriston and Tredegar Park

Yangs Well Pump Station –

St. Jago Heights, Thompson Pen, sections of Twickenham Heights, section of Tryall Heights, sections of Spanish Town, Greendale and sections of Mount View Estate

Nutshell Relift Station –

Cotton Piece, Charliemount Housing Scheme, White House Housing Scheme, Orangefield Village and Cassava Pond

Jericho Well –

White House, Banbury, Victoria, Orangefield, Jericho and sections of Linstead, York Street, Russell Pen and sections of Treadway

White River Treatment Plant -

Endeavour, Cascade, St. Mary Country club, Charles Town, Tree Hills, Rock Cottage and Industry Pen
