**URGENT MAINTENANCE WORK TO AFFECT WATER
SUPPLY TO SECTIONS OF ST. JAMES AND WESTMORELAND**

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that, operations at the Cambridge Treatment Plant in St. James, will be suspended from 9: 00 am Wednesday, March 14 until 5:00 pm Thursday, March 15, 2018, to facilitate urgent maintenance work at the facility.

As a result, customers in **St. James** and **Westmoreland**, who are served by this facility, will be without their regular water supply. Every effort will be made to complete the necessary work within the time specified. The NWC urges customers to store water for use during the outlined period.

Areas to be affected include: **Bickersteth, Seven Rivers, Richmond Hill, Shortwood, Cambridge, Cambridge Proper, Ducketts, Greenwich, Grange, Bethel Town, Argyle Mountain and Lambs River.**

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this disruption may cause and craves the patience and understanding of its valued customers.
