## NRW NETWORK IMPROVEMENT WORKS TO CONTINUE ...CORPORATE AREA WATER SUPPLY TO BE AFFECTED

The **National Water Commission (NWC)** and co-management partner, **MIYA**, will continue network improvement works in some sections of the **Corporate Area**, under the **Non-Revenue Reduction Co-Management Project**.

The Company is advising that in order to facilitate the installation of flow meters and gate valves replacement, it will be necessary to disrupt water supply to the following communities as scheduled.

Thursday, July 6, 2017	9am to 7pm	Norbrook Drive, Norbrook Road, Norbrook Crescent, Shortwood Road, Shortwood Drive Upper Mark Way, Carmel Avenue and surrounding areas.

Customers are being urged to store water for use during the period of disruption.

Meanwhile, the Company is reporting that effective **Monday, July 3, 2017**, pressure management activities will be implemented in some sections of **Cherry Gardens, St. Andrew**. These activities will involve a reduction of the network pressure levels in the following **District Metered Areas (DMAs)**.

Impacted areas will include **Upper Carmel Avenue, Carmel Terrace, Carmel Avenue, Garden View, Garden Close, Sunset Avenue, Cherry Drive, Upper Mark Way, Carmel Road, Upper Melwood Avenue, Oliver Crescent, Carole Close, Great House Close and Shortwood Drive to Cherry Gardens Boulevard**.
