WATER SUPPLY REGULATIONS

SPANISH TOWN AND ENVIRONS TO RECEIVE WATER SUPPLY ON SCHEDULED BASIS

The National Water Commission is advising that it will be implementing water supply regulations to sections of Spanish Town **commencing today, January 9, 2018**. This has become necessary to alleviate the water disruptions being experienced by some customers due to the heavy rainfall conditions that have forced the shutdown of the Spanish Town treatment Plant.

The areas to be served are as follows:-

DAYTIME: Between the hours of 8am to 5pm

Spanish Town Proper, Old Harbour Road, Sections of Johnson Pen Main Road, Willowdene, Sydenham Garden, Horizon Park, Brunswick Avenue Brunswick Main Road, El Prado Housing Scheme, Cromarty Housing Scheme, Leiba Gardens, Hopedale, Featherbed Road, White Water Meadows, Hartlands, Hampton Green, Valdez Road and all roads leading off.

NIGHTTIME: Between the hours of 5pm to 8am

Ebony Vale, Fairview, Sections of Fairfield Road, Sections of St. Johnson Pen, Frenchman Heights, Royal Place, Golden Acres, Strathmore Garden, Ardene Avenue, Fairfield Road and all roads leading off.

These regulations will remain in effect until the treatment plant has resumed normal operation. During this time, customers are still likely to experience reduced water pressures or some instances of outages. The NWC will seek to provide relief trucking of water for areas affected.

The National Water Commission apologises for any inconvenience that may be caused during the period of disruption.
