**WATER SUPPLY RESTORATION TO ST CATHERINE AND ST ANDREW**  
WHILE WORK ONGOING IN WHITE RIVER, ST MARY

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that water supply is now being restored to several communities that were impacted by a power supply issue at the Eastern Headworks facility.

The Company is indicating that most areas of St Catherine and St Andrew should have their regular water supply restored by early this afternoon, Sunday, February 11, 2018.

Areas include: **Kent Village, Eltham Vista, Simons, Hamilton Gardens, Christian Gardens & Pen, Newland Road, Cumberland, Cedar Grove, Edgewater, Waterford, Gregory Park, Braeton, Independence City and Hellshire, Spanish Town Road, Molyne Road, Waltham Park Road, Patrick City, Patrick Gardens, Washington Boulevard and Sections of Downtown Kingston**

Meanwhile, work is still ongoing to restore operations at the White River Treatment Plant in St Mary after the facility was shut down due to turbidity issues.

Areas include: **Endeavour, Cascade, Spring Valley, St Mary Country Club, parts of Balmoral, Charles Town, Ross Common, Three Hills, Rock Cottage, Grass Land, Industry Pen, Rose Street**

The NWC regrets any inconvenience that this disruption may cause and craves the patience and understanding of its valued customers.
