The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that, it will be carrying out maintenance work at the Pepper facility in Manchester, from Monday, February 19 to Sunday, February 25, 2018. During this period customers will experience low pressure or no water.

The NWC urges customers to store water for use during the outlined period and assures them, that every effort will be made to complete this necessary work within the time specified.

Areas to be affected include: *Downs, Prospect, section of New Forest, Farm, Sea Air, Spur Tree, Greenvale, Hatfield, Dunrobin, Balvenie, section of Mandeville, Georges Valley, Hillside, Richmond, Old England, Grey Ground, Ward Avenue, Heartease, Woodlawn Housing Scheme, Caledonia Road, Caledonia Meadows, May Day, Brumalia Road, Marshalls Pen, Mike Town, Balcarres, McKinley Road, Gordon Road and surrounding areas.*
