MAINTENANCE WORKS AT PROSPECT IN ST THOMAS NEARS COMPLETION
PUMP RE-INSTALLATION NOW UNDERWAY AT FACILITY

The National Water Commission is advising that customers served by the **Prospect Water Supply facility** in St Thomas can expect the restoration of their regular water supply by **Saturday March 10, 2018** as the company now moves into the final stages of maintenance works at the plant.

The plant was shut down to facilitate rehabilitation work which included the cleaning of the well at the site. During this very intensive process the team experienced some challenges which impacted the original timeline of completion, but the cleaning works have been successfully completed.

Areas Served include: **Industry Hill, Beckford Town, Johns Town, Prospect, Lyssons, Leith Hall, Blue Mahoe and Retreat**

Pending the re-installation of the pump, The NWC will continue the trucking of water to the areas most impacted by the works, inclusive of the Johns Town Community. Meanwhile, some communities are being served on a regulated basis to alleviate the inconvenience posed by the shutdown.

The NWC wishes to apologise to its valued customers for any inconvenience that these works may cause and seeks to assure them that every effort will be made to restore regular water supply in the shortest possible time.
